In a case when there is a cancellation after registration, applicants need to visit the International Student Services Office with their ID cards to apply for a refund of tuition **by Tuesday, August 8, 2017, 16:00** (full refund of tuition). If applicants withdraw their admission after the semester has started, tuition will be refunded according to SKKU's refund policy.
 - ※ The admission fee is non-refundable.

- C. For students who have graduated from foreign universities: The university applicants graduated from must be an officially approved institute of higher education by the national governments. If there are any problems or reasons for disqualification, admission will be cancelled.
- D. For students who have graduated from foreign universities: Applicants need to check whether the university where they are from is listed on the "List of Universities of the World" provided by the International Association of Universities (IAU) under UNESCO. If the applicants attended a university that is not on the list or the English name of the university is written differently, they need to submit a certificate issued by the embassy of their home nation to prove that the university is accredited by the government.

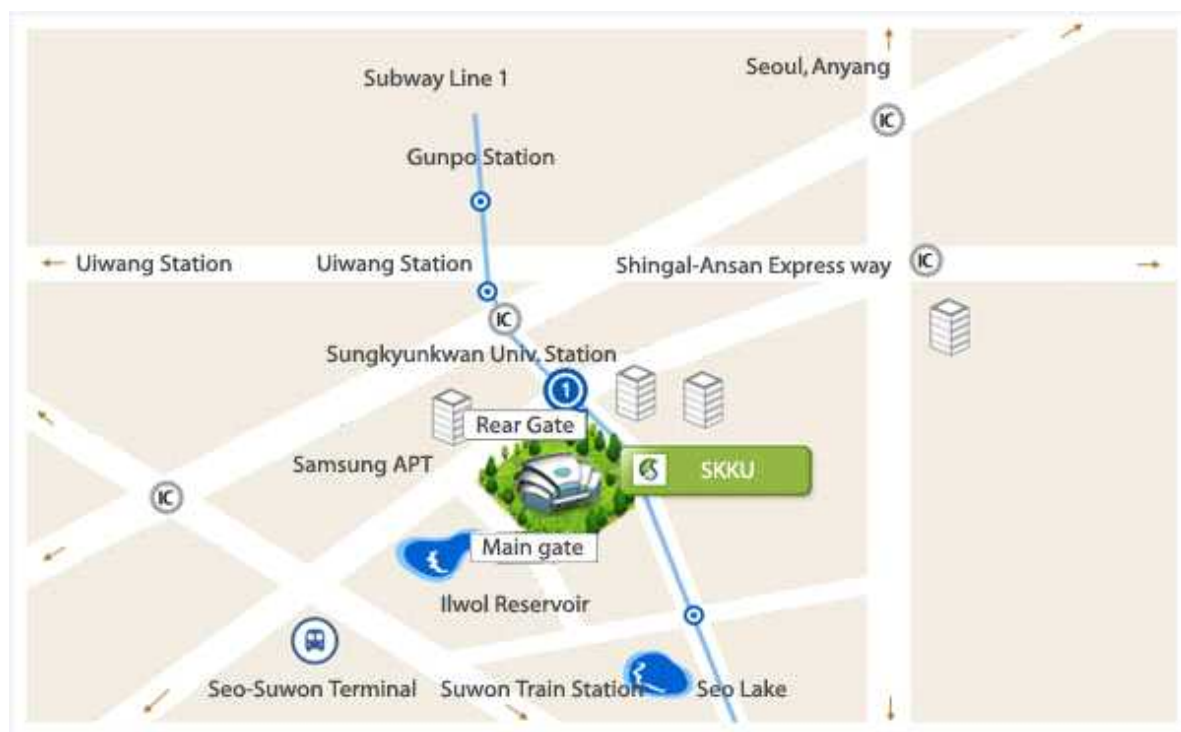
